





- OCD introduced a new category - Permanent Housing Placement (PHP) – as part of the PY2015 application.
- OCD grantees will start entering data into HMIS beginning January 2016.

#### **Policy or Program Issues**

- Mr. Gary asked committee members what agencies were entering into HMIS. Currently, Community AIDS Network is entering homeless information only and AIDS Resources of Ohio is entering information only for persons from Toledo/Lucas County. COMPASS Family currently is not currently entering data into HMIS.
- Julie Embree asked if viral loads and STRMU need to be entered annually in HMIS or every time a client receives service. According to the Data Standards Manual, T-cell and Viral Load should be collected at project entry, update, annual assessment and project exit. She also asked if clients receiving supportive housing without housing need to be entered into HMIS. Answers for these questions will be sought from COHHIO and the HOPWA workgroup and disseminated to all HOPWA grantees.

#### **Training Needs or Recommendations**

- Committee members discussed a variety of training opportunities, including a HUD training or webinar with other grantees to provide HOPWA compliance information.
